

Banyule digiDECL Women in Business Award 2016

Terms and Conditions

TERMS

1. ELIGIBILITY

Applicants will be eligible to enter the Women in Business Award 2016 providing all of the following criteria are met:

- a. She must be living in Australia;
- b. She must not be employed by the Melbourne Innovation Centre;
- c. She must not have a current license or membership agreement with the Melbourne Innovation Centre. for any of its business incubation or coworking spaces (including the Melbourne Innovation Centre, artDECL, The Station, and Banyule digiDECL);
- d. She must run an early-stage start-up business (defined as being in operation for a maximum of two years);
- e. She must be operating her own business, either as a sole trader, partner, company or not for profit;
- f. She must comply with the Terms; and
- g. She must submit her entry to enquiries@decl.com.au by 12.00 midnight Australian Eastern Standard Time on Friday 14th April, 2016.

2. ENTRIES

- a. Instructions on how to enter are set out on the Banyule digidecl website and form part of the terms
- b. Entry into the Award is deemed acceptance of the Terms
- c. The Period commences when the entrant submits an entry and ends on the 31st July, 2016.

3. INELIGIBILITY

We reserve the right to declare an entrant ineligible if, during the Period, in the sole and reasonable opinion of us:

- a. She is unable to represent or promote the Award in a satisfactory manner;
- b. She has not complied with the Terms; or
- c. Information in the entry is deficient, false, misleading, or provided unlawfully.

If, in our sole discretion, we determine that the winner (or her business or business partner) are/is involved in any conduct or activity in any way (including of a personal or business nature) that:

- d. Is illegal;
- e. Is fraudulent;
- f. May harm us, our name or reputation; or
- g. Breaches these Terms,

we may withdraw any award and associated prizes that she has received. If requested by us, the winner agrees to no longer promote herself and/or her business as being associated with the Women in Business 2016 Award. This clause survives the expiration of the Period.

4. INDEMNITY AND LIABILITY

- a. You will at all times indemnify, keep indemnified, defend and hold harmless us and our staff from and against any loss (including reasonable legal costs and expenses) or liability incurred by any of the Indemnified Persons arising from any claim, demand, suit, action or proceeding by any person against any of the Indemnified Persons where such loss or liability arose out of, in connection with or in respect of any breach of these Terms by you, and use of the Material and/or information supplied by you under these Terms; and
- b. To the extent permitted by law, we are not liable for any loss (including indirect and consequential loss) or damage or personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with the Women in Business Award 2016 including the supply of services by any person to you, and where applicable to any persons accompanying you.

5. PRIVACY & MARKETING

- a. We collect personal information and that relating to your business operations from the entry form. If entrants do not provide the

- personal and business information as requested, they cannot participate in the Award; and
- b. We will keep personal information strictly confidential; however, we will use business information (such as business name, type, location, and a brief description) of the winner for marketing purposes (including, but not limited to, our website, newsletter, and social media).

CONDITIONS
